

Position: Elderly and Healthcare Workers

Location: DENMARK (Lolland Municipality)

Do you want to work in the elderly and healthcare sector in a welfare state mutual trust between citizen, employee and manager is paramount?

Lolland Municipality, in Denmark, is looking for **skilled elderly care and healthcare professionals**. Your work will take place in a care center or as home care in private homes. In either case you will be working on the principle of 'helping people to help themselves', because being as self-reliant as possible increases the quality of life of the citizens.

Main tasks

- **Using welfare technology** and digital aids of various kinds
- **Personal care and practical help** for citizens with physical or mental disabilities
- **Supporting citizens' rehabilitation** and advising their relatives
- Contributing to a meaningful everyday life through conversations

Required profile:

- **At least 1 ½ years relevant vocational training** including knowledge about anatomy, hygiene, infection prevention, nutrition and health promotion
- You must also **have practical experience in caring for elderly people**
- Be willing and able **to learn Danish**. After two years in Denmark, you are expected to be able to complete the official Danish language course for foreigners.
- Very good command of **English (approx. Level B1 is needed)**
- At least **12 years** of schooling (**level 3**)
- Valid **driving license (category B)** and able to ride a **bicycle**
- You must be a **Citizen of an EU/EEA country, Switzerland or a Nordic country**
- If selected, a **criminal record** will be needed.
- You want **to settle in Lolland** and you **are able to cope with the challenges** of relocating and starting up a new job at the same time

The employer offers:

- **Permanent contract**
- **Net salary: 2335 € - 2522 €** at the time of hiring + 13% pension and paid vacation
- **37 working hours** per week. You will work rotating **shifts**.
- You will move to Lolland and **start working from 1st September 2025** and you will receive your first salary by the end of September
- **Basic Danish language on-line** course before moving + intensive Danish course after moving
 - Before you arrive in Denmark, you must follow an online Danish course in twelve weeks, two days a week (of 2.5 hours + preparation)
 - After your arrival in Denmark, you will attend an intensive Danish language course that lasts approximately 4 months + Healthcare introduction course
 - During these 4 months you will receive a basic salary of 2335 euros / net / month
- The employer **offers information and assistance to ease your relocation**, e.g., facilitate the initial registrations and help to find housing
- If you have a partner and/or children, a relocation requires **careful consideration**. The employer - Lolland Municipality - are committed to ensuring that the move is successful for everyone, providing all the support and assistance needed.
