The department in Vejle is part of the Mental Health Services in the Region of Southern Denmark. It's a professional independent unit responsible for mental healthcare and provides various types of services, such as inpatient ward, outpatient and emergency services to approx. 300,000 inhabitants. The department has FACT teams cooperating with the municipalities, and local emergency teams during the daytime. We work interdisciplinary and collaborate across sections with attending specialist physicians, doctors in specialization, psychologists, physiotherapists, nurses, social workers, healthcare professionals and healthcare secretaries.

Main responsibilities:

- Diagnostic evaluation, plan the course of treatment and discharge of patients.
- Assessment, diagnosis and treatment of mental disorders.
- Individual follow-up of patients; Somatic examinations and follow-up.
- Collaboration in interdisciplinary teams and with the municipal healthcare service.
- Participate in admissions meetings/assessments of referrals.
- Professional and clinical meetings with other therapists, nurses etc.
- Supervision of doctors in specialization.
