The Danish Veterinary, Food, Agriculture and Fisheries Agency is seeking official veterinarians for permanent positions in our meat inspection units, starting in autumn 2026. The positions are open to international candidates who are motivated to relocate to Denmark.

Key Responsibilities

You will become part of the agency's meat inspection service, which oversees the inspection of live animals and meat at slaughterhouses across Denmark. Our purpose is to ensure that food produced in Denmark complies with both national and international standards.

The work is carried out from the agency's local inspection sections, which are physically located at the slaughterhouse you are assigned to. You will be part of a team consisting of veterinarians, inspection technicians, administrative staff, and a section manager.

We are looking for a person who:

Required qualifications:

- You can speak and write English
- Practical experience with meat inspection is not required

- Are interested in working within a public authority and performing on-site inspection
