INL operates under its own institutional legal framework and reports in accordance with the International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS).

This foundational position was established in accordance with INL's Financial Rules and aligns with the best practices of the Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA) and the International Organization of Supreme Audit Institutions (INTOSAI). The selected candidate will establish the Internal Audit Service of INL, define its charter and methodology, and build its relationship with INL's governance bodies, including the Finance Committee and the INL Council.

- MSc or relevant professional certification (i.e., CIA, CPA, or CISA) is preferred and will be given significant weight in the selection process.
- **Minimum of 7 to 10 years of experience in internal auditing**, with a meaningful portion in a senior or leadership role. Candidates with fewer years but exceptional relevance — particularly those with experience in international organizations, multilateral institutions, or complex public-sector environments — are encouraged to apply.
- Strong working knowledge **of internal audit standards** and practices, including IIA International Standards.
- B2/C1 English Level (as it's the official language of INL).

The company offers:
